

Raya Divers Dive Team NEWSLETTER

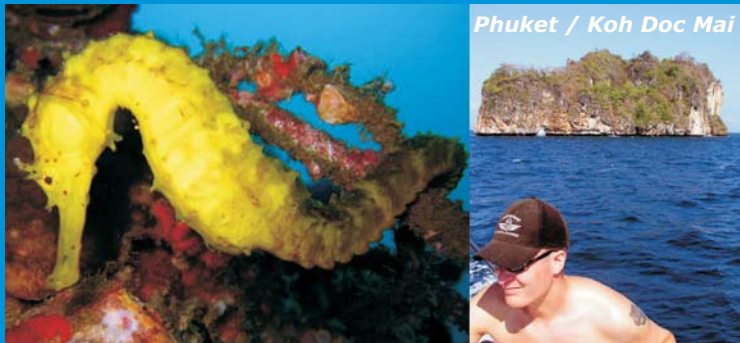
Dive information, stories and some news about diving in Thailand!
